



Oceans Apart, a thirteen-year-old mare, is from an illustrious family and she herself showed plenty of ability on the racecourse, finishing a close second to Flashy Wings, a subsequent dual Group 2 winner, on her debut as a two-year-old. She won a Windsor maiden on her third start and was rated 91 at her peak. Oceans Apart ended her career in America and retired to the paddocks in 2007.

Oceans Apart is out of the prolific producer of high-class winners, Ffestiniog and is a half-sister to Pattern race winners Border Patrol, Brecon Beacon, Eisteddfod and Boston Lodge. She has produced six foals to date and was perhaps unlucky that her first foal, a filly by Giant's Causeway, did not win a race, as she showed ability on two starts for Mark Johnston before suffering a career-ending injury. Oceans Apart currently has a four-year-old gelding in training with Doug Watson in Dubai.
