




True North has run consistently well as a three-year-old, winning once and being placed four times. He has an excellent temperament and is effective over 1m2f plus. Currently rated 69, which is the average rating of all Flat horses in training who have been assessed by the handicapper, True North will hopefully improve again as a four-year-old in 2018 as he steps up in trip and matures further. Trainer Sir Mark Prescott feels that True North will benefit both physically and mentally, from another season on the Flat, but given True North's ability to stay, there is always the option of going hurdling further down the line.
