



Clarendon Street is a good-looking son of Court Cave, who caught the eye on his only start to date, in a competitive bumper race at Punchestown in April. This five-year-old travelled strongly throughout the race and stayed on in an eye-catching manner. Clarendon Street has a very good staying pedigree and is from the family of Irish Grand National winner, Rogue Angel. Court Cave has sired a number of high-class jumpers, including Court Minstrel, Champion Court and recent Grade 1 Neptune Novices' Hurdle winner at the Cheltenham Festival, Willoughby Court.

Clarendon Street will be trained by current Champion Jumps trainer, Nicky Henderson, in Lambourn. Nicky is one of the most successful Jumps trainers of all time and his best horses include See You Then, Sprinter Sacre, Binocular and current Champion hurdler, Buveur D'Air. Clarendon Street's future lies over fences ultimately, but he is likely to contest a bumper this autumn, before going novice hurdling.

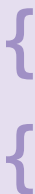
