



Farouk De Cheneau is a good-looking four-year-old gelding, who has run three times over hurdles in France, winning his last start in good style at Vittel. He is by Day Flight, who has produced a number of good Jumps horses, including multiple graded-winner, A Toi Phil. His dam (Kardamone) has produced three winners over Jumps from three runners and is a daughter of Network, who is a highly influential broodmare sire and has produced the likes of Sprinter Sacre, Saint Are and recent Galway Plate winner, Borice.

Farouk De Cheneau is an exciting hurdles prospect this season, but he also has the scope to hopefully do well over fences in time, too.
