Also a winner on the Flat over a mile and a quarter, Jaboticaba has all the attributes to hopefully make him an excellent hurdling prospect with the size and scope to go chasing in time. Jaboticaba could not have been more impressive on his hurdling debut, pulling right away in the closing stages to win in great style. Jaboticaba is by Muhtathir, who has sired a number of high-class jumpers, including Kruguyrova and Pacha Du Polder.

Jaboticaba will head into training with Alan King at Barbury Castle, Wiltshire. Alan has enjoyed a huge amount of success with juvenile hurdlers over the years, including the mighty Katchit, who won the Grade 1 Triumph Hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival before landing the Champion Hurdle the following year.
