



This very good looking four-year-old gelding won his sole start over hurdles in France and made a highly promising British debut for his owners at Warwick on 23 February 2018. Sent off the 5/2 second favourite, Jaboticaba travelled well into the race and finished second to a more experienced rival. Also a winner on the Flat over a mile and a quarter, Jaboticaba has all the attributes to hopefully make him an excellent hurdling prospect with the size and scope to go chasing in time. Jaboticaba is by Muhtathir, who has sired a number of high-class jumpers, including Kruguyrova and Pacha Du Polder.

Jaboticaba will head into training with Alan King at Barbury Castle, Wiltshire. Alan has enjoyed a huge amount of success with juvenile hurdlers over the years, including the mighty Katchit, who won the Grade 1 Triumph Hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival before landing the Champion Hurdle the following year.
