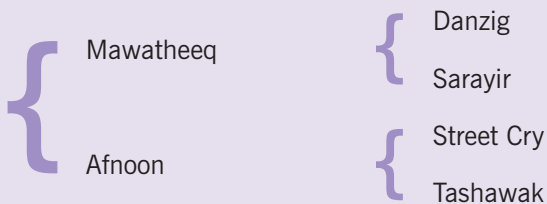




Kings Inn finished third on his hurdling debut at Taunton on ground that was unsuitably soft. It was then a case of waiting for better ground in the spring and Kings Inn finished fourth on his next start at Ludlow in May. Kings Inn's next start was on the Flat at Chepstow and he ran really well over the mile and a half trip to finish third behind two useful types under Megan Nicholls. Kings Inn didn't set the world alight on his handicap debut at Newbury in June but Paul Nicholls felt that his Flat horses were not in great form at the time and Kings Inn probably needed a break by this time as he had been on the go for a very long time. Still only four-year-old, Kings Inn looks to be in great physical shape after his summer break and Paul Nicholls is hoping that he can show improved form over hurdles this season.
