



Paris Dixie is an attractive four-year-old bay filly, who won a bumper at Carlisle on her latest start (24 February). She is by the promising sire, Champs Elysees. She has shown promise in her bumper starts and showed a good attitude on her last start, to record a clear-cut success with some fancied runners in behind her. The form of her third place at Carlisle back in November has worked out well and Paris Dixie looks an ideal type to go novice hurdling next season. Paris Dixie is to be trained by champion trainer, Nicky Henderson, from his Seven Barrows stables in Lambourn, Berkshire. Paris Dixie should stay at least two and a half miles and appreciates some cut in the ground.
