



Rainbow Rebel has been an incredibly tough and likeable individual for his owners. Despite not winning, in August of his three-year-old campaign, he won four races on the bounce, improving from a mark of 67 to 86. Between October 2016 and March 2018, Rainbow Rebel showed just how consistent he is by running 18 times, finishing second five times and third three times. After such a consistent run of form, including on the all-weather this winter, he returned to the scene of his excellent second back in November 2017, when finishing second to a useful horse, and won in good style under Joe Fanning. This win came off a reduced mark of 80, which had only recently been lowered by the handicapper because of his consistency. It was great for all connections to see Rainbow Rebel get his head back in front and he is probably a better horse on turf than on the all-weather, so with the Flat season in full flow, we are very hopeful there will be more wins to come from him and hopefully he will continue to give his owners lots of fun.
