



Tambourine Girl is a lovely two-year-old filly by Cable Bay. This attractive filly was purchased at the Tattersalls Yearling Sale (Book 2) last autumn and impressed with her willing attitude, excellent walk and strong physique. Cable Bay boasted excellent form from six furlongs to a mile and landed a Group 2 on his final start as a four-year-old. He has enjoyed a very good start to his career as a stallion and his first winner, Electric Ladyland, broke the juvenile course record at Lingfield before following up next time at Kempton. This filly's dam, Triton Dance, won over five furlongs as a two-year-old and has produced two black type horses, including Listed winner, Miblish.
